For the first time in its 20-year history, Compagnie du Ponant will position two of its four ships in Asia to operate itineraries in the warm waters of Thailand and Malaysia and along the coast of Vietnam, Hong Kong and China.

From November until February, they will call at the old colonial ports of Penang, Belawan and Malacca, drop anchor in quiet bays and visit the pristine maritime park of Thailand's Similan Islands.

One itinerary set to appeal to Australians is the 14-night sailing from Singapore with seven ports of call around Vietnam. From bustling Ho Chi Minh City with its fading French-colonial charm, the ship will call in at the beach resort of Nha Trang, then make its way to Da Nang for a visit to the lovely UNESCO-World-Heritage-listed town of Hoi An.
